



On-going Volunteer Opportunities:

- Volunteer Teacher Naturalists (VTN's)** - Lead outdoor hikes and programs with students during the school day. Training is provided.
- Desk Receptionists** - Greet visitors and provide receptionist duties at the Ecology Center's front desk. Training is provided.

Outdoor Park & Grounds Projects - Trail maintenance, planting, weeding, watering plants, seed collection, and other activities.

Critter Care - Assist with feeding, exercise and care of Maywood's critters and the cleaning of their habitats. Training is provided.
