



COVID SAFETY INFORMATION

Updated May 28, 2021

Maywood strives to provide a safe environment for our visitors, program participants, volunteers, instructors and staff. Effective May 28, 2021 and until further notice the following COVID-19 safety guidelines are being practiced at Maywood:

- Mask wearing and social distancing are strongly encouraged for all unvaccinated individuals over the age of two.
- We support mask wearing and social distancing in gatherings where the vaccine status of other individuals may be unknown.
- Caretakers for unvaccinated children are asked to assess the risks for the children participating in programs or events at Maywood and decide based on their personal assessment if the child(ren) should attend.
- Indoor programs and gatherings will be limited to 50 people or less.
- Any individual who is not feeling well, is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, is awaiting the results of COVID-19 test, has tested positive for COVID-19, or has been exposed to COVID-19 should not attend programs or events until the CDC's recommended quarantine time has passed.

These guidelines may be updated at any time based on recommendations from local, state, and/or national health departments or government authorities or if there is a change in the local number of COVID cases.
